SDF, as an umbrella financial institution for SAARC project and programs is fully committed to promote regional integration and economic cooperation among the SAARC Member States through project funding and collaboration.

SDF has taken a number of initiatives for strategic growth of the South Asian region, such as forging relationships with multilateral and domestic institutions for taking up joint initiatives and also co-funding of projects.
